## Sanofi Expands UK Probiotics Presence With DioraByota

Sanofi Consumer Health Care leans into probiotics trend with another UK probiotic supplement, DioraByota.

<u>Sanofi Consumer Healthcare</u> is leaning further into the global trend for probiotics with another probiotic-based gut health supplement in the UK.

Like Buscobiota, DioraByota – which combined the *s. boulardii* probiotic with dietary fiber and vitamins B6 and B12 – is being marketed as a general, "one-a-day" gut health solution.

"Formulated to support gut health, new DioraByota is a unique one-a-day strawberry flavoured sachet, containing 5bn of the extensively researched s. boulardii live cultures," Sanofi explains.

"The live cultures are designed to reach the gut alive to support live bacteria levels," it adds. "The unique formulation dissolves in the mouth, meaning no need for additional water, making it ideal for travelling or for those on-the-go."

Consumer Healthcare's Silvina Vilas, marketing director for UK and Ireland, told HBW Insight that DioraByota would "help empower people to live healthier, happier lives."

"Supporting the digestive system and the 'gut microbiome' provides a wealth of benefits to our overall health, yet with today's busy lifestyles, we understand it can sometimes be difficult to keep everything working effectively," Vilas said.
